- 2) *Be willing* to be set apart (Leviticus 20:7-8)
- 3) *Accept* the process of sanctification (1 Thess. 4:3)
- 4) *Cooperate* with God, the Artist (Philippians 3:12)

The Results of Sanctification

- 1) *Holiness* is a result of sanctification.

A DEFINITION:

Holiness is *being of one mind with God*

The Results of Sanctification

- 1) Holiness is the result of sanctification.
 - *The Word of God* will lead you to a place of holiness.
(Deuteronomy 33:3)
 - Without the Word of God, the world becomes the
 authority for what you do in life (James 4:4)
- 2) Sanctification will protect us from
 guilt and the power of sin (1 Cor. 1:30)
